Teachers then incorporate it into their school curriculum. The Montana Chamber Foundation provides scholarship assistance through sponsor contributions.



Company teams are formed and compete with other high schools across Montana in a simulated business that manufactures and markets a Compact Personal AM-FM and Video Disk Player.

Each week, which is equivalent to a business Quarter, students make decisions in areas of:

- Ethics in Business

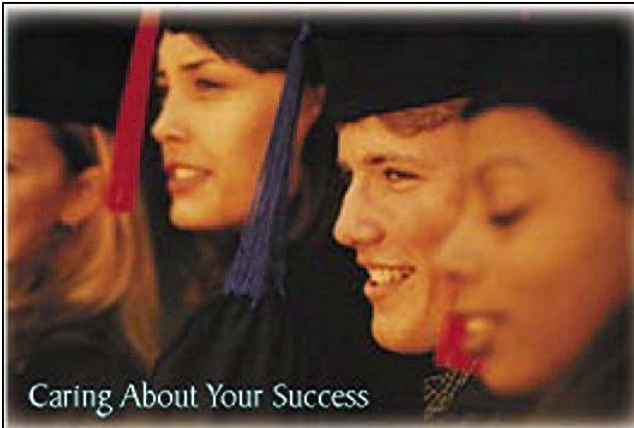
