The Prospects: Participation Agreement, Eligibility Requirements and Media Waiver

Any of Montana's 40,000+ high school students are eligible to submit their ideas for new, innovative business ideas, or present their existing businesses. We are also accepting entries that articulate how to solve challenges, generate revenue to fund solutions, and create value.

The Prospects is open to all Montana high school aged students, from public (online and in-person), independent, or religious schools, homeschooled, or HiSET.

We encourage CTE students participating in other school clubs (BPA, DECA, FCCLA, and FFA, TSA, HOSA, SKILLS USA or other community youth organizations like 4-H, Scouts, and Boys & Girls Clubs) to adapt their projects to meet the requirements of The Prospects.

Students can enter The Prospects as individuals or as teams. If a team wins any of the prizes, the MONTANA CHAMBER FOUNDATION will distribute the award (in-full) to the team's educator (or other school official) for distribution and accounting. The MONTANA CHAMBER FOUNDATION holds no responsibility for the equitable distribution of awards and prizes amongst team members. Winners will be judged and awarded based on the submission received, not the team member participants.

The MONTANA CHAMBER FOUNDATION does not discriminate based on the groups, classes, or other categories to which our participants are perceived to belong. We accept all submissions, regardless of race, gender, age, religious affiliations, sexual orientations, political ideologies, Grizzlies or Bobcats; and we expect that any other components of this competition, personal characteristics or sensitivities to which you may take offense, has been a simple oversight and unintentional.
