SUCCESS IN THE 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

PRIORITY BILLS PASSED

Reducing Business Taxes:

- Business Equipment Tax Exemption Raised to \$1 million
 - Benefits construction, agriculture, manufacturing, and other businesses

Controlling Insurance Costs

- Seven Chamber-proposed bills tackled tort reform to reduce frivolous lawsuits and curb litigation expenses
- Reducing litigation costs helps control insurance costs for Montana businesses and families

Protecting Industry & Jobs

- Montana Environmental Policy Act Clarified to Exclude Greenhouse Gases
 - Ensures essential energy and natural resources companies can continue to operate

JANUARY 10-11, 2024 | HELENA

In January of every year, the Montana Chamber hosts Business Days at the Capitol. This event coincides with the start of the legislative session (odd-numbered years) and candidate filing (even-numbered years) with a focus on legislative and public policy issues relevant to business. Traditional seminars include 'Eggs & Issues' with the legislative leadership and the 'Last Word' by the Governor. An evening of networking rounds out this event.

NEW! - MARCH 6-8, 2024 | BOZEMAN

For the first time in March 2024, the Montana Chamber will host the "Blazing Trails" Montana Women in Business Summit at the Kimpton Armory and AC Hotel Downtown Bozeman in conjunction with International Women's Day on March 8th. Leadership, career advancement, entrepreneurship, financing/venture capital, and women in policy. Monies raised will support the Montana Chamber's childcare policy initiatives in the 2025 Legislative Session.

MAY 21-22, 2024 | BUTTE

To recognize one of our state's leading industries, the Montana Chamber of Commerce will host an inaugural event to celebrate National Travel & Tourism Week - #NTTW (May 7-13) and tourism's intersection with the film and outdoor recreation industries as vehicles to harness the power of place, #TheLastBestPlace, as an economic driver for communities around Montana.
